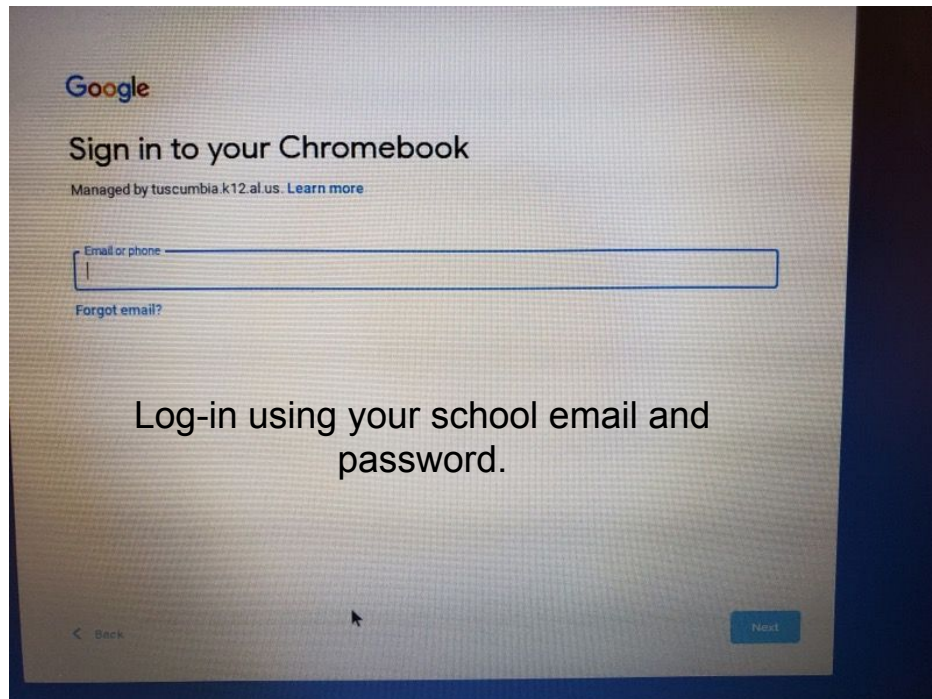
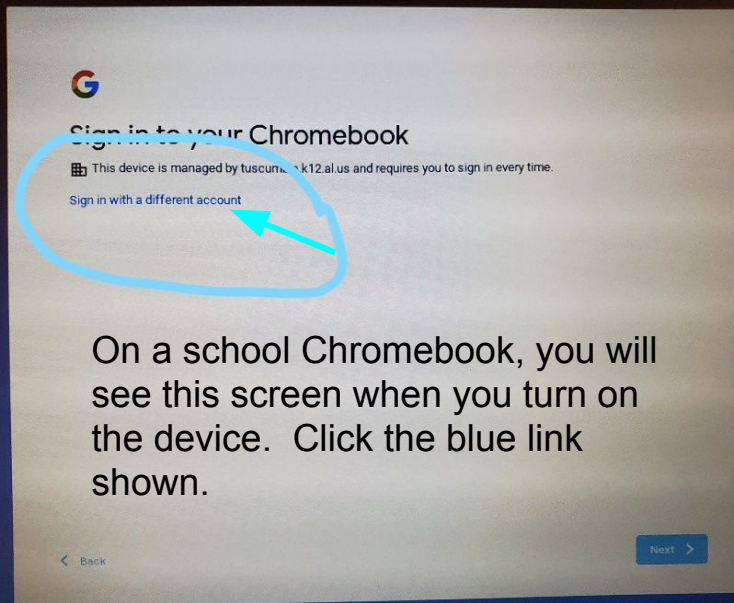


Google Classroom

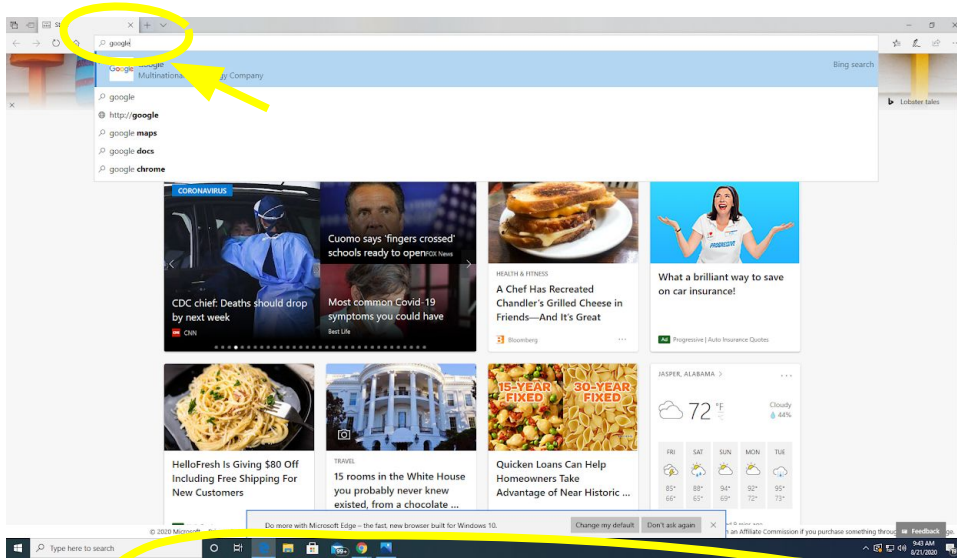
Google classroom will be used for all students. This includes face-to-face students and virtual students.

How to log-in to school Chromebook

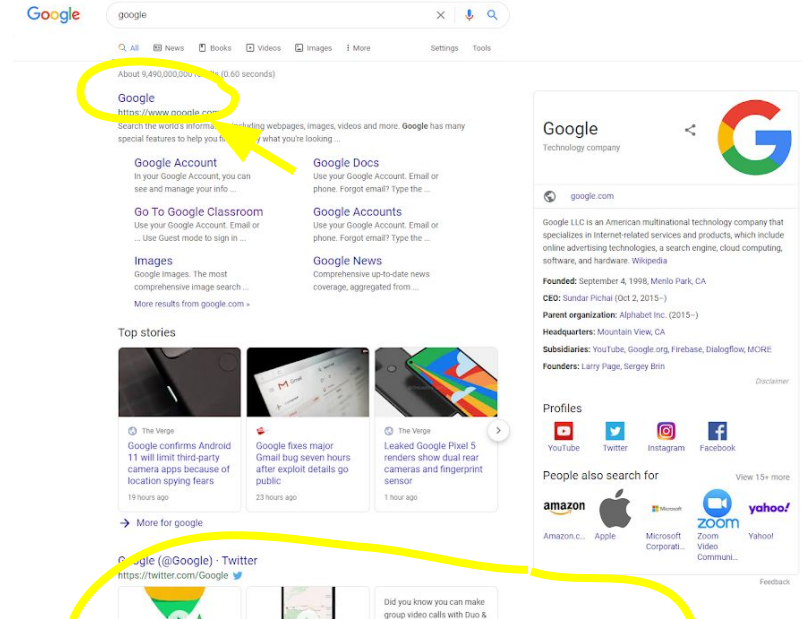


Using a personal device:

Virtual students may use any device that will connect to Google via a web browser.

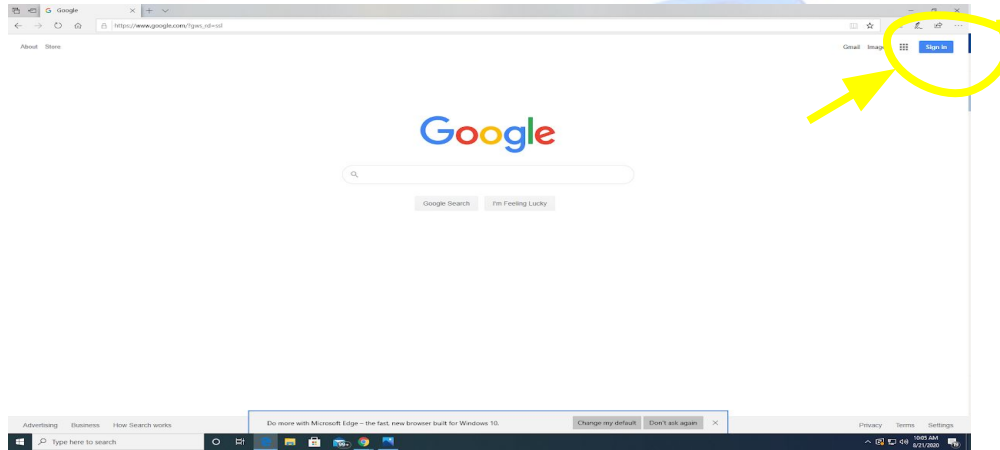


If your browser is not set to Google as your homepage, just type “google” in the address bar.

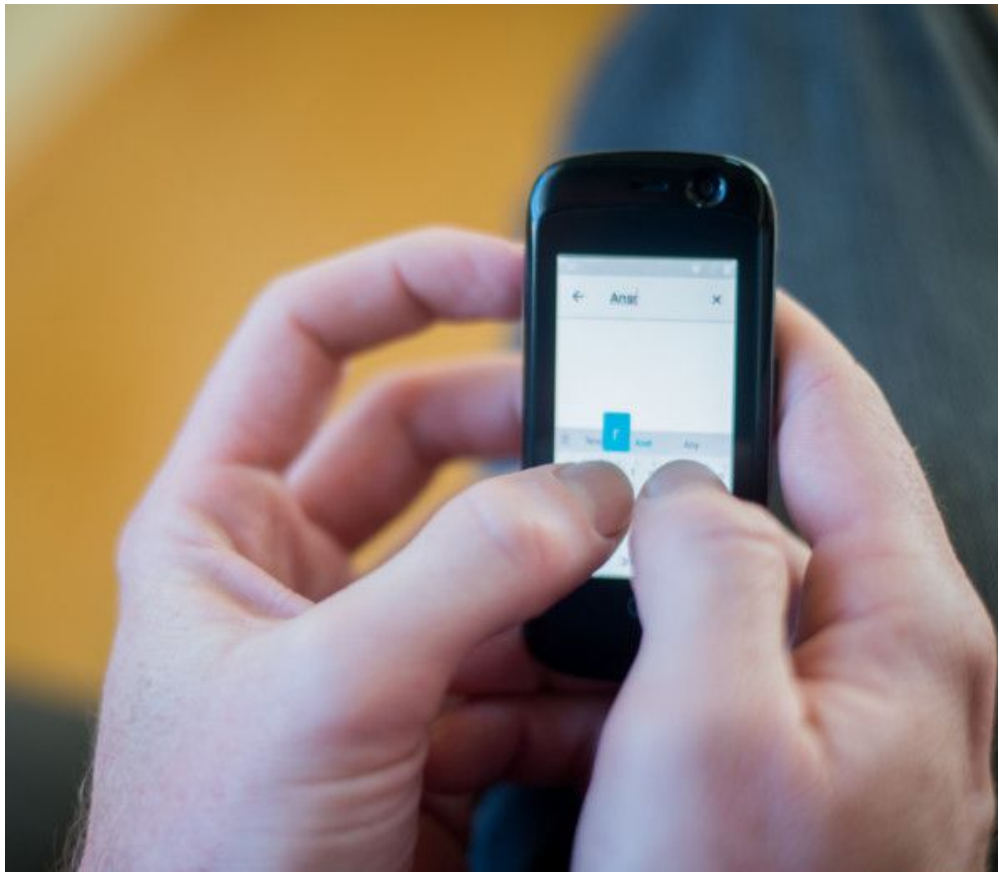


Click on the “Google” link

Log in to Google

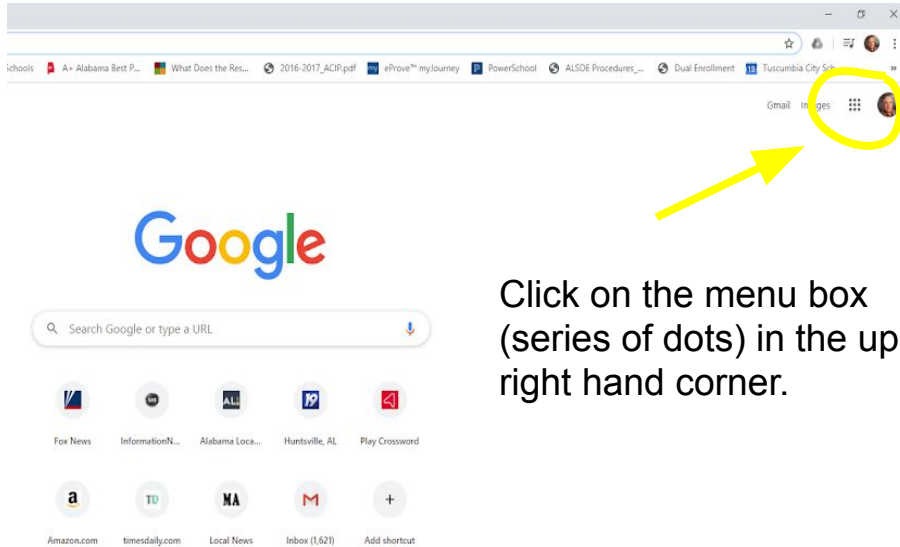


Sign-in using your “tigertales” email any time you are completing work in Google classroom.

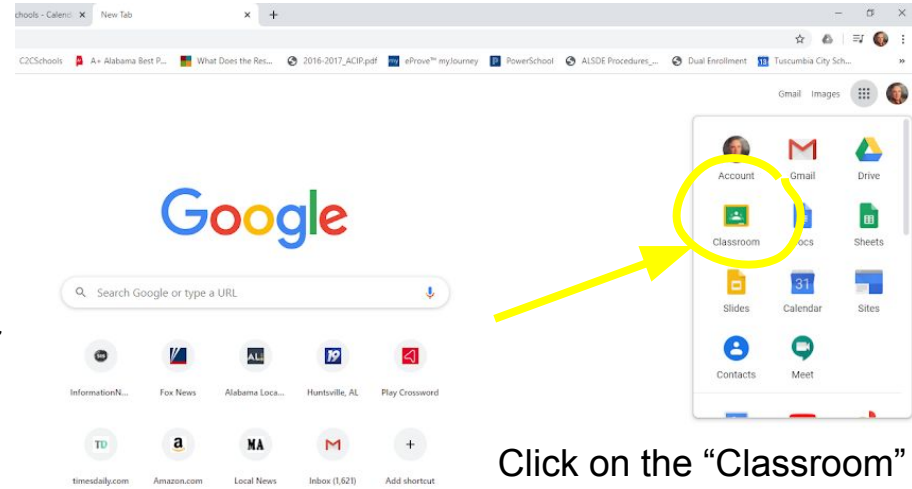


We recommend **NOT** making a cell phone your primary device due to the small screen and absence of a traditional keyboard.
